1. People want to **DO** good to please God. But no one is good enough (Psalms 14:3; Jeremiah 17:9; Luke 18_18-19; Romans 3:10)
2. Jesus Christ has **DONE** everything possible to please God for the sake of sinners. Only Jesus Christ is perfect (John 1:29; John 19:30; Luke 18:18-19; Hebrews 4:15)

Relevant scriptures

DO

They have all turned aside; together they have become corrupt; there is **none who does good**, not even one. (Psa 14:3 ESV)

The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?
"I the LORD search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds." (Jer 17:9-10 ESV)

And a ruler asked him, "Good Teacher, **what must I do** to inherit eternal life?"
And Jesus said to him, "Why do you call me good? **No one is good except God alone.** (Luk 18:18-19 ESV)

as it is written: "**None is righteous, no, not one**; no one understands; no one seeks for God. All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one." (Rom 3:10-12 ESV)

For **by works of the law** no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin. (Rom 3:20 ESV)

DONE

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, **who takes away the sin of the world!** (John1:29 ESV)

For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, (Rom 8:3 ESV)

When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, "**It is finished,**" and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. (John 19:30 ESV)

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been **tempted as we are, yet without sin.** (Heb 4:15 ESV)
