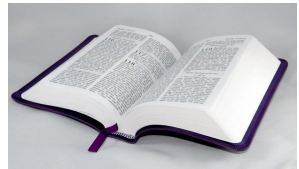

AFFIRMATION OF MEMBERSHIP


